

HALLOWEEN AT THE CLUBHOUSE

SPOOKTACULAR SATURDAY is the first event scheduled for Saturday, October 24. At this event, Seven Oaks residents can carve a pumpkin and/or stuff a scarecrow (see photos on page 5). The clubhouse will provide the pumpkins for \$5.00.

To make a scarecrow, residents only have to bring the clothes to dress the scarecrows. The

clubhouse will provide the straw and post. When completed, the scarecrows will be placed in front of the clubhouse so residents can vote for their favorite. The person who built the scarecrow that receives the most votes will get a special gift. Several days before Halloween, each builder of their scarecrow can pick it up and display it in their own yard.
